Eligibility

You are eligible to earn the Cash for Apps on the Mutual of Omaha Insurance Company Medicare supplement business you place as a broker producer (personal production only; individuals or agencies may not qualify based on business placed by down-line producers) in California. Excludes internal/affiliate conversions.

Qualification Period

All Mutual of Omaha Insurance Company Medicare supplement net-issued applications in California from March 26 – May 31, 2014 will earn cash.
